Attendance Policy

- Being on time and at school every day is important for your success.
- Clear absences within three (3) days by: ATTENDED -parent phone call to the attendance office -bringing in a note
- Hours will be assigned for the following:
 - Tardies /Tardy Sweeps (½ hour)
 - Period Absences/Truancies (1 hour)
 - Discipline/Behavior (1-4 Hours)



Attendance Policy (cont.)

Clear your hours by attending: •Saturday Academic School (SAS) •After-School Tutoring •Participating in Clubs or other school sanctioned activities

Be accountable for the time you miss from class and school!



Dress for Success!

- No provocative clothing or headwear, including: (tube tops/spaghetti (2 in. strap), short shorts, undergarment, sagging pants, gloves etc.)
- No negative images include but are not limited to the following: *tobacco, drugs, weapons, nudity, etc.*
- Inappropriate dress wear will lead to immediate corrective actions





Electronic Devices

- Electronic devices may not be used during instructional time unless your teacher is having students use the devices as an instructional tool.
- This also applies to the use of devices by students inappropriately outside of class *during* instructional time.



If device is confiscated by staff member, it will be sent to office and only be released to parent.

Skateboards and Bicycles

- All skateboards and bicycles must be locked up in racks.
- Students must provide their own locks
- Skateboards cannot be carried around campus during the school day
- Students are not permitted to ride skateboards or bicycles <u>at anytime</u> while on campus at CHS
- Violation of these rules will follow progressive discipline

If skateboard or bicycle is confiscated by staff member, it will be sent to office and only be released to parent





Lunch Passes



- Passes will be available to 11th and 12th grade students only.
- Lunch pass applications will be available this Wednesday August 30th from Student Services (at brunch or lunchtime only)
- Qualify for a Lunch Pass by:
 - **<u>completing application</u>** and attaining student AND parent signatures
 - having a **3.0 GPA or above** (previous grading period)
 - **positive attendance** (free of multiple tardies and truancies)
 - positive behavior
- Lunch Passes *may be revoked* at any time if qualifications are not met throughout the year.

Be accountable for YOUR attendance, behavior, and academics!!!



Entering and Leaving Campus

Once on campus you must remain on campus unless you: -have been checked out in person by a parent or guardian through the attendance office -have a lunch pass (Main and Student Lots only) -are done with your instructional day

Students <u>who do not have a **6th period**</u> may wait in the library or quad for their seventh period to begin.
