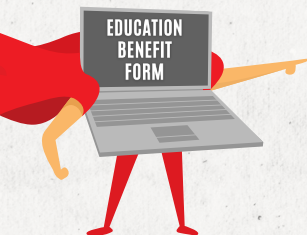


Want an extra serving?
