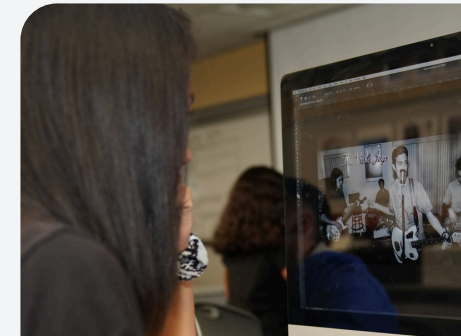
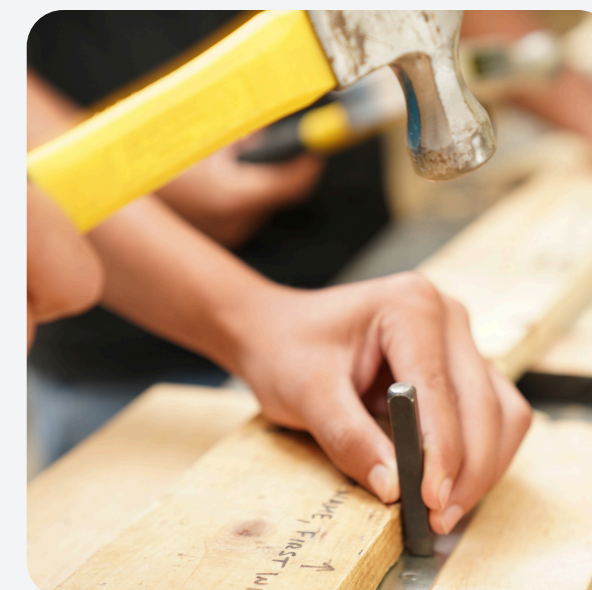
## AP Capstone

## Meet the 4 Year College Requirements (A-G Requirements)

- A.** Social Studies - **2 Years Required** (World History, US History)
- B.** English - **4 Years Required**
- C.** Math - **3 Years Required**, 4 Recommended (Must include Math 1, Math II, and Math III)
- D.** Science - **2 Years Required**, 3 Recommended (1 Life Science and 1 Physical Science)
- E.** Language Other Than English - **2 Years Required**, 3 Recommended
- F.** Fine Art - **1 Year Required**
- G.** College Prep Elective - **1 Year Required**

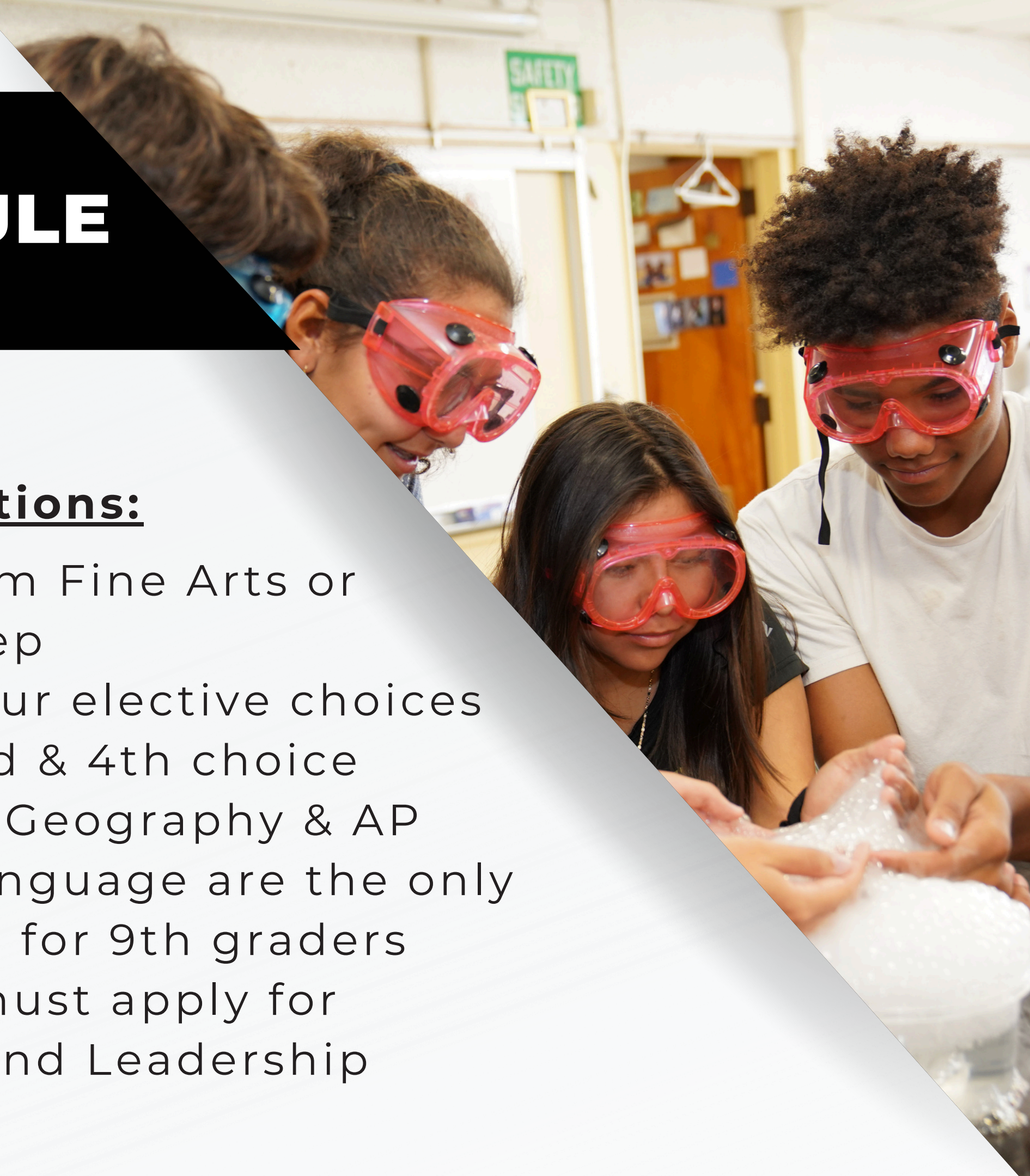

# STUDENTS EARN CREDITS FOR PASSING CLASSES EACH SEMESTER

5 Credits  
for each  
class

Credits Needed to Graduate: 220

**30** credits Social Science (3 Years, World History, US History, Govt/Econ)

**40** credits English (4 Years)

**20** credits Math (2 Years, must include Math I)

**20** credits Science (2 Years, must be 1 Life & 1 Physical)

**10** credits Fine Art OR Language other than English (1 Year)

**20** credits PE or Sport or Marching Band (2 Years)

**80** credits Electives





# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Each class = 5 credits per semester  
7 classes each SEMESTER (**5 credits each**)  
35 Credits per semester = 70 credits per  
year
