
AP Capstone


- Northview is the only school in the Covina-Valley District to offer the AP Capstone Diploma.

COURSES TO PREPARE FOR COLLEGE

Meet the 4 Year College Requirements (A-G Requirements)

- A. Social Studies 2 Years Required (World History, US History)
- B. English 4 Years Required
- C. Math 3 Years Required, 4 Recommended (Must include Math 1, Math II, and Math III)
- D. Science 2 Years Required, 3 Recommended(1 Life Science and 1 Physical Science)
- E. Language Other Than English 2 Years Required,
- 3 Recommended
- F. Fine Art 1 Year Required
- G. College Prep Elective 1 Year Required

Must pass all classes with a "C" or better!






