Upcoming Changes to Board of Trustees Election Process

Our District is changing the way we elect our Board of Trustees and we would like your input!

We are adopting an election method known as "by trustee area" elections, which means each trustee must reside within a designated boundary, referred to as a trustee area, in the Covina-Valley Unified School District and is elected only by voters that live within that trustee area. The District currently uses an election method referred to as "at-large" elections where anyone who is eligible to run for office can reside anywhere in the District and be voted on by all of the voters in the District.

We will host three community meetings to discuss this change. Your input will help our Board of Trustees decide which trustee area boundaries will be most effective to help meet the needs of our students and community. After these community meetings are held, our Board of Trustees will review your input prior to holding public hearings to select a final trustee area map and sequence of elections.
