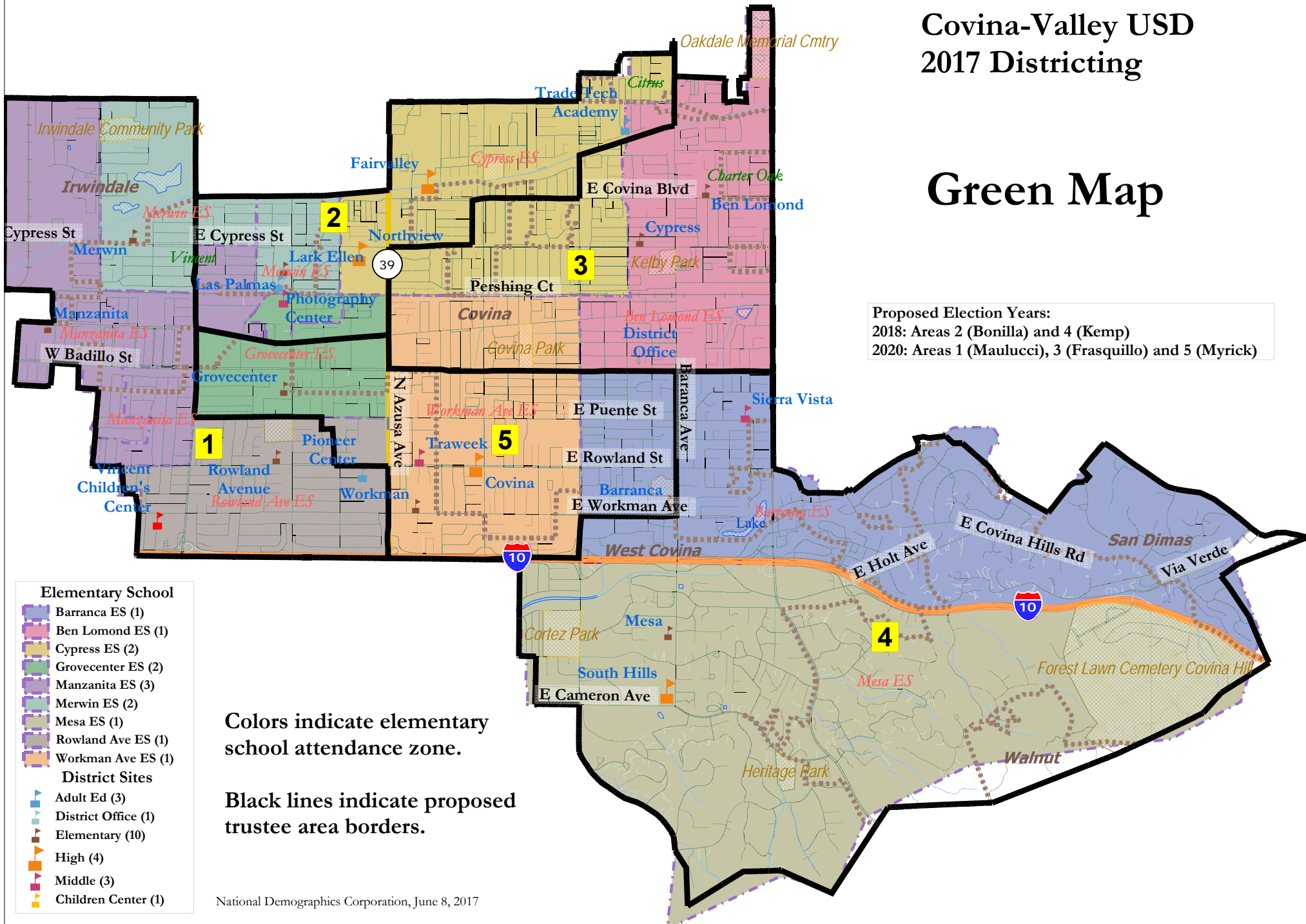


Covina-Valley USD 2017 Districting
