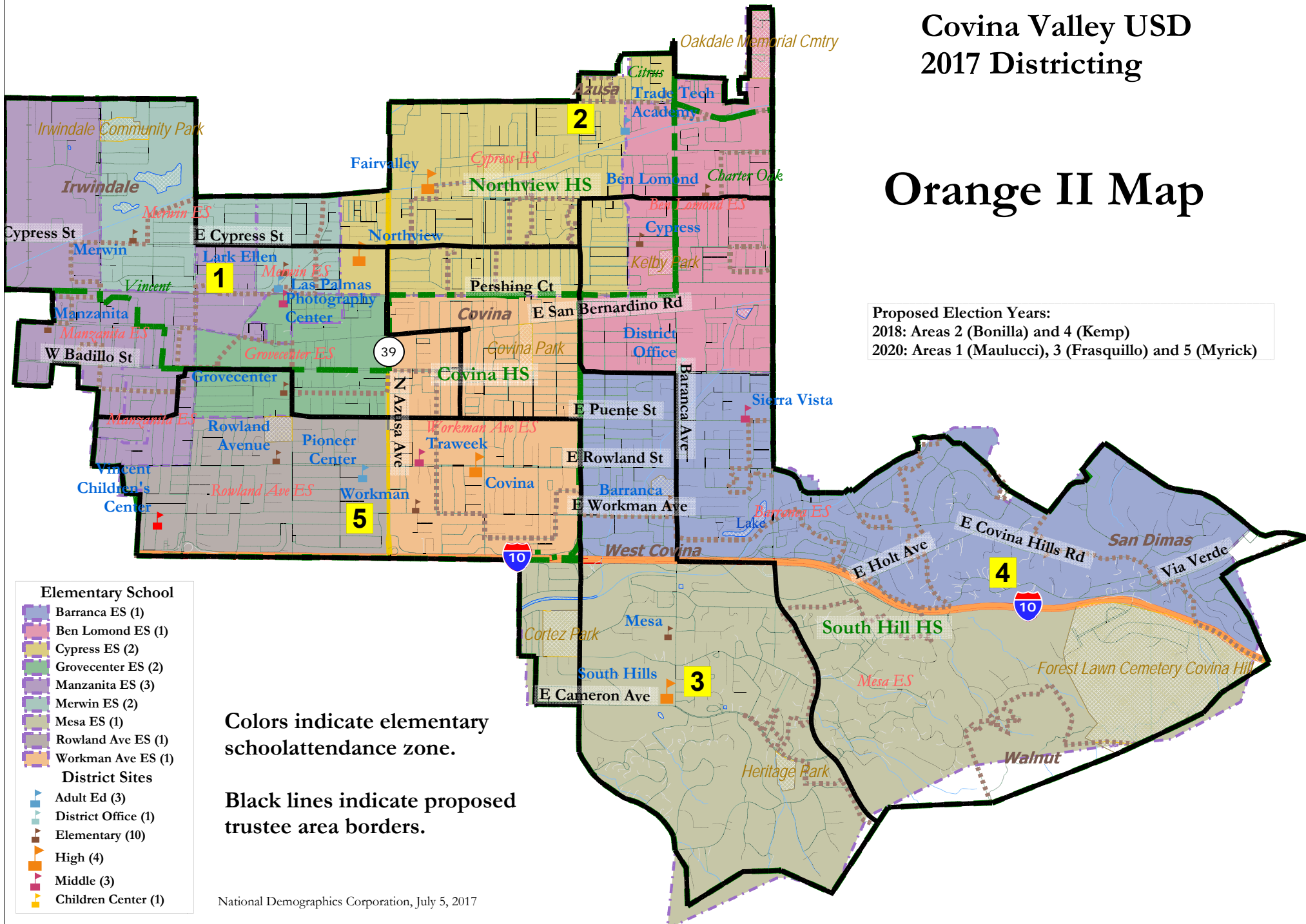


# Covina Valley USD 2017 Districting
