<b>Physical Education</b>	<b>20 credits</b>	<u>Special Note:</u> Colleges require a grade of “C” or higher. Any D’s must be re-taken for admission consideration.  NCAA Clearance is required to compete in college athletics

### **California School Dashboard- College/Career Indicator**

The College/Career Indicator measures how well schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation. High school graduates must meet at least one of the measures in the prepared level:

- CAASPP: Score of Level 3 “Standard Met” or higher on both English (ELA) and math
- Advanced Placement (AP) Exams: Score of 3 or higher on two AP exams
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Exams: Score of 4 or higher on two IB exams
- Completion of Dual Enrollment: Two semesters of college coursework with a grade of C or better
- Complete a-g course requirements with grades of C or better **plus** one of the Additional Criteria below
- CTE Pathway completion with a grade of C or better in the capstone course **plus** one of the Additional Criteria below

#### Additional Criteria

- SBAC Level 3 or higher on ELA and at least a Level 2 “Standard Nearly Met” in mathematics
- SBAC Level 3 or higher on mathematics and at least a Level 2 “Standard Nearly Met” in ELA
- One semester of Dual Enrollment with a grade of C or better
- Score of 3 on one AP exam or score of 4 on one IB Exam (for a-g requirement only)
- Completion of CTE Pathway (for a-g requirement only)
