

Covina High School **Emergency Response Protocol**

IN AN EMERGENCY **TAKE ACTION**



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

ADULTS

Close and lock the door Account for students and adults Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

Return to inside of building Do business as usual

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door

ADULTS

Recover students from hallway if possible Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

STUDENTS

Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

ADULTS

Lead students to Evacuation location Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. **ADULTS**

STUDENTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

Safety Strategy

Evacuate to shelter area Seal the room Drop, cover and hold

Get to high ground

Lead safety strategy Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults






Protocol When Entering Campus






Student Parking Lot Off of Rowland & Hollenbeck




BULLYING/HARASSMENT and GAGGLE



Bullying is defined as any severe or pervasive physical or verbal act or conduct that includes, but is not limited to:

- sexual harassment
- hate violence
- intentional harassment
- threats, intimidation or communication made in writing or through means of an electronic/internet/web-based related act directed against school district personnel or pupils, committed by a pupil or group of pupils that has the effect or can reasonably be predicted to have a negative effect on others.




