Who Needs to Create an FSA ID?

- Every student who has a social security number will be filling out the FAFSA.
- To begin the FAFSA, you must have an FSA ID
- If a <u>student does not have a social security number</u>, then they
 will fill out the California DREAM ACT Application, and <u>they do not</u>
 <u>need an FSA ID</u>.
- Before applying for an FSA ID, the student and parent should make sure they know how their names look on their Social Security Cards.

Who Needs to Create an FSA ID? (continued)

- When creating your FSA ID, your name must be typed in to match the way your name is written on your Social Security Card.
- ONLY ONE PARENT needs an FSA ID.
- If a parent does NOT HAVE a social security number, it's okay, they
 will not be able to create an FSA ID; so the student should just focus
 on creating their own FSA ID.

Who is Considered a Parent? (continued)

Once you have identified who is considered to be your parent, you can now decide who you re going to create an FSA ID for.

If you have two parents, pick one to create an FSA ID.

If you have one parent, then that parent will need to create an FSA ID.

If you do not have a parent, and you are in foster care, then you will only create an FSA ID for yourself and you do not need to create an FSA ID for your parent.
