## PIANO ACCOMPANIST

### DEFINTION

Under general supervision, to play the piano accompaniment for dance or musical groups; and to do related work as required.

### EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Plays piano accompaniment for choral classes, concerts, and other programs; may improvise and compose music; may maintain files and records of music; may conduct sectional rehearsals.

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

#### Knowledge of:

- Choral conducting;
- Choral repertoire;
- Reading a musical score in parts.

#### Ability to:

- Accompany musical groups as they rehearse and perform;
- Transpose simple musical arrangements;
- Arrange and improvise music;
- Sight read difficult musical selections;
- Establish and maintain harmonious relationships with students and adults.

#### Experience:

- Some experience in accompanying choral or musical groups.

#### Education:

- Equivalent to completion of twelfth grade supplemented by extensive courses in music and piano playing.
