POOL MAINTENANCE WORKER

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, to maintain swimming pool and related areas in a clean and orderly condition; and to do related work as required.

Examples of Duties

Brushes and vacuums pool and cleans filters; cleans tile and washes down pool decks; conducts chemical tests of water and applies chemicals; maintains filters, back wash, and pump house; drains and acid washes pool; performs routine maintenance and repairs to pumps, equipment, and machinery used in the operation of the pool; assists with aquatic sports activities by setting up or laying out equipment; cleans locker room, and related facilities; keeps simple records.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Methods, materials and equipment involved in the maintenance and operation of swimming pools.

Ability to:

Operate and maintain pools and related equipment in accordance with prescribed standards;
Maintain schedules required for proper pool maintenance;
Perform normal maintenance and cleaning services of pools and other assigned areas and furnishings;
Carry out oral and written instructions;
Work cooperatively with others.

Experience:

Six months experience in the operation and maintenance of swimming pools.

Education:

Equivalent to graduation from twelfth grade.
