Technical Support Data Analyst - Adult Education

### **Definition**

Under general supervision, oversee collection and entry of data into Adult Education's Student Management Systems; generate and disseminate data reports to Adult Education administration and staff; provide technical support services for all of Adult Education's computer users; and perform other duties as required.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Serve as Administrator of Tri-Community Adult Education (TCAE) Student Data Management Systems, ASAP, and TOPSpro Enterprise;
- Assist in data submission to TCAE's various reporting agencies;
- Participate in TCAE's Data Advisory Committee (DAC), Instructional Leadership Team (ILT), and Mt. Sac Consortium Conferences, Meetings, and Webinars;
- Attend data collection training as hosted by AEBG, TAP, OTAN, and CASAS;
- Maintain and regularly update school website;
- Liaise with District TSS Department in all interagency technical matters;
- Perform installation, configuration, and support of TCAE computer hardware and software.
