

What is Spanish Dual Immersion?

At Las Palmas, students in the Spanish Dual Immersion Program are given Spanish by a Spanish-speaking teacher in their History and Spanish Literature classes. Students also take English Language Arts, Math, History, P.E., and one additional elective in English.



Students will achieve excellence in both Spanish and English while gaining the practice of speaking in a foreign language, which is an essential component in the retention of the language.

Students help each other to speak, read, write, and understand one another's language.

What are the goals of the Spanish Dual Immersion Program?

Students can continue to learn skills that will promote biliteracy in Spanish and English so that at the high school they will be eligible to take AP Spanish exams and receive college credit as early as their freshman year. By taking and passing the AP Spanish Exam in High School, Spanish Dual Immersion students are fulfilling one of the needed requirements to attain the Seal of Biliteracy upon graduation.
