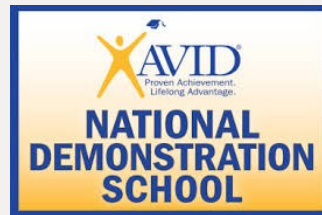


SCHEDULE FOR SPANISH DUAL IMMERSION STUDENTS

What is Spanish Dual Immersion?

At Las Palmas, students in the Spanish Dual Immersion Program are given Spanish by a Spanish-speaking teacher in their History and Spanish Literature classes. Students also take English Language Arts, Math, History, P.E., and one additional elective in English.



What are the goals of the Spanish Dual Immersion Program?

Students can continue to learn skills that will promote biliteracy in Spanish and English so that at the high school they will be eligible to take AP Spanish exams and receive college credit as early as their freshman year. By taking and passing the AP Spanish Exam in High School, Spanish Dual Immersion students are fulfilling one of the needed requirements to attain the Seal of Biliteracy upon graduation.



The Benefits of Two Languages



There is extensive research that shows kids in Spanish Dual Immersion will perform higher than their peers learning just one language. The program ensures students successfully learn both languages as the year progresses.
