## COVINA-VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

## Qualifications for Membership on Personnel Commission

To be eligible for appointment or reappointment to the Commission a person shall (a) be a registered voter and resident within the territorial jurisdiction of the school district and (b) be a known adherent to the principle of the merit system. No member of the governing board of any school district or a county board of education shall be eligible for appointment, reappointment or continuance as a member of the Commission. During the term of service a member of the Commission shall not be an employee of the Covina-Valley Unified School District.

As used in this section, "known adherent to the principle of the merit system" with respect to a new appointee shall mean a person who by the nature of prior public or private service has given evidence of supporting the concept of employment, continuance in employment, in-service promotional opportunities and other related matters on the basis of merit and fitness. As used in this section, "known adherent to the principle of the merit system" with respect to a candidate for reappointment shall mean a Commissioner who has clearly demonstrated through meeting attendance and actions that the Commissioner does, in fact, support the merit system and its operation.
