

- Growth mindset








### Importance of scores for admission/class placement

- → Each spring, all grade eleven students in California take CAASPP assessments in English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics.
- → These assessments serve as an indicator of readiness for college-level coursework in English and mathematics and are used by the California State University (CSU) and participating California Community Colleges (CCCs) to determine Early Assessment Program (EAP) status.

## Factors To Consider When Choosing A College

#### SIZE

What is the total student population? How big are the typical freshman classes?

#### **LOCATION**

How far is the college from home? Is it in a rural, urban, suburban setting? What is the area around the campus like? What is the weather like?

#### PEOPLE

Who are the students and where do they come from?

#### **ACADEMICS**

What majors are available? Who teaches the courses? What is the academic reputation of the college?

#### **SOCIAL OPPORTUNITIES**

What clubs and teams are available? Are there fraternities and sororities?

#### **COST**

What is the total cost of attendance, including tuition, room and board, books? What kind of financial aid is available?

## Reach, Target, Safety Schools

### Reach

10-20% chance of acceptance

- Dream school
- One that you shouldn't expect to be admitted to a REACH to get in
- → GPA/SAT are below average range for acceptance

### Target

50-60% chance of acceptance

- → On target for acceptance
- → GPA/SAT are within average range for acceptance

### Safety

90% chance of acceptance

- Certain that you will be accepted
- → GPA/SAT are above range for acceptance
- → Financially safe



- Public 4-year universities
- Online application: \$55.00 per campus
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 in A-G courses
- Grades of C or better in A-G courses
- No personal statement
- No teacher or counselor recommendations accepted
- Approx. cost \$23,000 per year to live on campus

The CSU, with 23 campuses is a leader in supplying graduates with the necessary technical and personal skills to be successful in the working world.



# Impaction

#### **Program Impaction:**

A campus receives more eligible applications for a <u>specific undergraduate</u> <u>program</u> than there are enrollment spaces available.

#### Campus Impaction:

A campus receives more eligible applications than there are enrollment spaces available for the <u>class level</u> (freshman and transfer).

#### **Local Admission Area:**

Applications received from students from outside the designated local area will be held to higher admission requirements than those received from students inside the local area for certain impacted campuses. Our local area school is Cal Poly Pomona.

All undergraduate programs, pre-programs, and undeclared/undecided programs are impacted for the following campuses:

- → Fresno State
- → Cal State Los Angeles
- → CSU Fullerton

### CSU Impaction - Majors

The following majors are more selective and will often require a higher GPA than other majors:

- Nursing
- Engineering
- Psychology
- Biology/Biological Sciences

- Online application: \$70.00 per campus
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 in A-G courses
- Grades of C or better in A-G courses
- Exam Requirement: SAT Test with Writing or ACT are optional
- Personal Insight Questions
- Volunteer and Extracurricular Activities
- No teacher or counselor recommendations accepted
- Approx. cost \$34,000 per year to live on campus

## Private/Out-of-State

#### Private/Out-of-State Universities

- → 77 Private Universities/Colleges in CA- Thousands Out-of-State
- → Vary in size, prestige, and cost
- GPA/SAT score requirements vary
- → Deadlines and application requirements vary

















### W.U.E.

- Western Undergraduate Exchange
- Students who are residents of WUE states are eligible to request a reduced tuition for participating two and four year college programs outside of their home state.















#### States include:

Alaska, Arizona, California,
Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana,
Nevada, New Mexico, North
Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota,
Utah, Washington, Wyoming,
Northern Mariana Islands.



## California Community Colleges

- 113 Community Colleges in CA
- Prepares students to transfer to a 4 year institution
- Associate's degree (2 years)
- Offers technical training in specific occupations (cosmetology, culinary arts, automotive, welding)
- Most are nonresidential; students live off-campus
- Students can attend part-time or full-time
- To enroll, students have to be 18 + or have a High School Diploma









## Community College

- CCCApply.org
- Links you to community college application page
- Ex: Mt. SAC, Citrus, PCC (113 statewide)
- Application Dates: Deadlines vary
- Online application is <u>free</u>
- Students only need to graduate from high school
- No SAT or ACT needed
- Entry Level Math and English Exam required to determine class placement


- College Talk


- In the Google Apps waffle, select Naviance for Students
